Research & Choices

- Research resorts/locations to find a place that aligns with your desires and comfort level. Be sure to check reviews and talk to others who have been, if possible.
- Familiarise yourself with the resort's rules. Make sure they align with your expectations.
- If travelling internationally, ensure your passport is valid and that necessary visas/vaccinations/etc are obtained.
- Purchase travel insurance if desired.

Finance

- Notify your credit cards or bank of your travel plans, particularly if travelling internationally.
- Bring some cash just in case!

Health

- Get tested for STIs. For yourself and for the safety of others, too!
- Pack some basic first-aid items.
- Pack insect repellent, especially for tropical destinations.
- Pack medications.

Tech, Toys, & Communication

- Bring chargers for all your electronics.
- Bring bedroom toys, chargers, and kink gear.
- Download apps that might help you socialize and connect with others particularly helpful for group events.

Packing

- Bring comfortable clothing for non-nude areas, events, and going off property.
- Embrace a sarong or wrap. They're versatile and can be used as quick cover-ups.
- Have swimwear options, even if you plan to be nude most of the time.
- High-quality sunscreen—protect all parts of your body that might not usually see the sun.
- A hat for sun protection.
- Swim towel (if not provided by the resort or you have a special one).
- Toiletries and cosmetics—including any needed for theme nights.
- Nice evening wear for dinners.
- Costumes or outfits for theme nights or parties.
- Footwear for outfits, tours/adventures, and including sandals or flip-flops/ thongs.
- Protection & lube, including condoms, dental dams, or other protection. Even if you don't intend to swing, it's better to be prepared!
- Travel-sized hand sanitiser.

Last-Minute

- Recheck all bookings.
- Review the resort's/group's rules regarding consent and behavior.
- Ensure luggage is packed and ready to go.
- Set alarms for departure day. You don't want to miss travel times!
